

Title: In Vino, Veritas

Quest giver: Teacher - Grammaticus (Roman school)

Intro dialogue: [Teacher] *Governor, I'm in dear need of your assistance! A small while ago I made a couple of requests for wine and eel for an upcoming symposium, but the delivery is nowhere to be seen! It is imperative that I receive this order - posthaste, as the secrets we can discover could end up stirring the oceans and sundering the heavens!*

Objective 1: A teacher at the *Grammaticus* roman school asks, in a state of slight panic, for your help in securing a delivery of wine and eel for their upcoming symposium. Once the request is delivered, the teacher graciously thanks you and gifts you a small reward. **[goods delivery]**

Objective 2: After securing the wine and eel for the teacher, they come to you once again to ask for assistance, now in an immediate hurry. The teacher explains that the sweet baked goods they had ordered from the baker have been delayed, but that it is critical that they receive this delivery - for research purposes! Once the goods are delivered the teacher thanks you and provides you with a small reward, again. **[goods delivery]**

Objective 3: The teacher, now seemingly inebriated and a bit lethargic, pleads for your help in finding 5 of the philosophers and theologians that got lost during the revelries of last night's symposium. The teacher provides you with some hints on where the scholars could have wandered off to. **[picture puzzle]**

Objective 4: After you find the scholars meandering about at different locations you find out from them, in their rambling, drunken stupor, that the last night's symposium topic had been focused on the research of *'Unraveling the Delicate Balance of Lethargy, Leisure, and Pleasure'*; questionably a subject of importance. You can now either decide to reprimand the teacher for wasting time and resources or indulge their ideas for possible benefits in the future. **[decision]**

Option A: If you decide to reprimand the teacher, they will be sorry, but annoyed by your dogmatic leadership, but provide you with a medium sized restitution reward.

Option B: If you decide to indulge the teacher by letting them explore these *unique* ways of teaching, they will be elated and promise to do everything they can to grow the might of the empire, with the addition of a possible larger reward in the future

Outro dialogue:

- Option A (reprimanded): *I'm sorry Governor, though I expected you to be more open to experimental innovation, and I assure you that this was all for the sake of worldly understanding and research! Please take this as recompense for my actions.*
- Option B (indulged): *Ah, I see you are a person of true vision! I assure you that my thorough research will not disappoint!*
