

Title: Intercultural Exchange

Quest giver: Grammaticus

Intro dialogue:

"Governor, I humbly ask you for help! Interest in the Roman way of life has recently increased considerably, certainly not least because of your inspiring and energetic leadership. We have difficulties in coping with the influx of new learners - we lack both books and magisters. Dear governor, can I hope for your benevolent support in this matter?"

Objective 1:

"We need your wisdom, governor!"

The increasing interest in Roman culture pushes the local school to its limits. Among other things, there is a lack of teaching material. This is certainly an easy exercise for your organizational talent.

[Goods Delivery: 20x Books]

Objective 2:

"Another step on the way to knowledge."

In addition to new books, qualified teaching staff are also needed. Time to let your contacts play and redeem a few favors.

[Search quest: 3x educated Romans, they appear near higher-level Roman dwellings]

Objective 3:

"We will not accept this so easily."

Your increased promotion of Roman culture arouses resentment among the defenders of ancient traditions. They demand the inclusion of traditional craftsmanship and language in the curriculum of the educational institution in order to counteract an imminent loss of their culture.

[Decision]:

- [Option A]: Teaching only Roman culture
 - "The future of this country is Roman, and that is how it should be taught."
 - o Possible effects:
 - e.g. -10 satisfaction of Celtic population levels for 30 min.;
 - Uprising is triggered [If there is such a thing in the game?];

- +10 Happiness of Roman populations;
 - Item with advantages for Roman population levels/production buildings etc.
- [Option B]: Include Celtic knowledge in the curriculum
 - "The Celts are skilled craftsmen. It would be unwise to let this knowledge deteriorate."
 - Possible effects:
 - +10 Celtic Population Happiness,
 - Item with advantages for Celtic population levels/production buildings etc.

Outro dialogue:

Option A:

"My most humble thanks, governor! In this way we should be able to do justice to everyone who wants to study the Roman teachings!"

Option B:

"My most humble thanks, governor! In fact, existing knowledge should also continue to be cultivated!"

Reward overall quest: e.g. item that affects schools (range, happiness or similar)
